Change from Non-Half Hourly to Half Hourly Billing

Dear Sir/Madam

PREMISES:- AS ABOVE ADDRESS

It has been brought to our attention that your electricity supplier has recently changed the registration of your supply from Non-Half Hourly (NHH) over to Half-Hourly (HH) billing. This means that your metering equipment will provide measurements of electricity supply for settlement purposes on a half-hourly basis.

We own and operate the distribution system that is used to provide a supply of electricity to your premises. In addition to a contract you may have with your electricity supplier, you also need to have an Agreement with us for a connection to our distribution system. The Connection Agreement will identify the Authorised Supply Capacity (ASC) that will be used to base our capacity charges made under the HH regime to your electricity supplier upon.

Before we agree the ASC we may need to check that your service equipment and the surrounding distribution system is capable of providing the capacity you require safely. If it is not, this may result in a loss of your supply and / or damage to the electricity network supplying your site.

On this basis therefore, can I ask that you complete the attached **Request for an Authorised Supply Capacity** form and return it to me at the above address or by e-mail return; dlightwood@westernpower.co.uk
